



Amidst the Pahang rainforest at 5,000 feet above sea level, Fraser's Hill is a naturalist's paradise, boasting innumerable plant, bird and animal species. It's a popular destination for those who are interested in nature-based pursuits such as trekking, bird watching, horse riding, fishing, and camping. Fraser's Hill is similar to a small Scottish village with granite colored mock Tudor buildings dotting the landscape.
